


Windows 10 Instructions

- 1. Select Start ■, then select Settings ۞ > Apps > Apps & features.
- Select <u>Tech Tool Installer</u> to remove, and then select <u>Uninstall</u>.



Note: If more than one Tech Tool Installer is listed uninstall all instances.

REBOOT the computer when the Uninstall is completed.


Windows 8 & 8.1 Instructions

- 1. To begin, access the **Start Context Menu**:
 - Windows 8: Hover the cursor in the bottom-left corner of the screen until a small image of the Start Screen appears, then right-click on the icon to open the Start Context Menu. Select Programs and Features.
 - Windows 8.1: Right-click on the Start icon
 in the lower left-hand corner to open the Start Context Menu. Select Programs and Features.





2. Select the Tech Tool Installer and click Uninstall to remove it.



Note: If more than one Tech Tool Installer is listed uninstall all instances.

REBOOT the computer when the Uninstall is completed.


Windows 7 Instructions

1. To uninstall an application, use the uninstall program provided by Windows 7. Start by clicking on the **Windows icon**.






2. In the right pane, click on **Control Panel**.




3. Under Programs click on the item Uninstall a program.





4. Windows then lists all programs that were installed using Windows Installer. Select the **Tech Tool Installer** application then Click at the top on **Uninstall/Change**.
